Play Active is Australia's first program to boost energetic play in early learning

Young children's physical activity, health, and development



3–5-year-olds get an average of 370 minutes a day of total physical activity



They need <u>60 minutes</u> of **energetic play every day**, but most get 30-40 minutes only



Moderate to vigorous physical activity improves social-emotional development (especially for boys), self-regulation, and cognitive school readiness



Living close to rivers and the ocean, and in semirural neighbourhoods = more physical activity for young children



Bigger yards = more active play



Screen time recommendations (<60 mins) at early learning are met, but young kids get too much overall (107 minutes)



92% get enough sleep/ day



Dog ownership increases physical activity (+16 minutes a day) and reduces socialemotional problems

More trees and green space:



At early learning = **more** outdoor time and physical activity



At home = less being unhappy, worried, or clingy



More traffic = less physical activity



More space to run and a range of play equipment at early learning = more energetic play
